## Sunday Check-out Procedure

- (1) Pack your Troop gear and transport to vehicles or stack at campsite
- (2) Troop cleans up Deep Freeze campsite, lean-to or cabin and adjacent paths & trails
- (3) Scoutmaster (or his designee) conducts a Site Inspection
- (4) Troop corrects deficiencies
- (5) Scoutmaster (or his designee) picks up Troop's Health Forms at Norris Hall after the Sunday morning Closing Ceremony

**The "Outdoor Code": Clean, Careful with Fire,  
Considerate and Conservation-minded**

- \_\_\_ Fires are dead out, including charred logs
- \_\_\_ Fire rings are dismantled and fire pits are cleaned of paper, aluminum foil and garbage
- \_\_\_ Unused, scavenged firewood is returned and scattered
- \_\_\_ Split firewood (from home) to a nearby woodshed or stacked to take back home
- \_\_\_ General campsite area is free of paper, foil and garbage
- \_\_\_ Adjacent paths & trails are free of paper, foil & garbage
- \_\_\_ Trash is bagged and ready to be transported BACK HOME
- \_\_\_ All Troop and personal gear has been removed from the site (or is stacked and ready to go)
- \_\_\_ No excessive damage to Mother Nature
- \_\_\_ **Our cabin/campsite is cleaner than we found it**
