Register at the White House (front room). Ask for "Renegade Chief" Terry Quintin or his able "Assistant Renegade Chief" Ray Judd.

Pay **NO registration fees!** Visiting Cub Scouts will each receive a **FREE** Official Event Patch! (That's right, there's **NO CHARGE** for visiting Cubs, leaders or parents).

Pick up a **Visitor's Guide** that includes a map and descriptions of the Klondike Derby Events. Take a Self-guided Tour of "Klondikaven". See some very talented Boy Scouts in action!

Please park your cars in the lot directly across the road from the White House. **Do NOT park along Boyhaven Road**... your vehicle may be ticketed by the Sheriff! Be careful crossing Boyhaven Road and watch for Scouts who may be mushing your way!!

Observe events from designated Visitor Areas. It gets pretty hectic at the Stations when up to a dozen Scout patrols are busy demonstrating their skills. Stay out of their way!!

Dress warmly! Be sure that your Scouts and Leaders are prepared for the weather. If someone does get cold, there are trained first-aiders and warming huts nearby (Horsley Lodge and the White House). Hot drinks will be available.

Bring bag lunches if you plan to be in Camp during the noon hour. (There's a good pizza shop on Route 29 west of Camp and Saratoga Springs is only ten minutes east on Route 29).
