

Troop Leader's "Deep Freeze"

HEALTH & SAFETY CHECK-LIST

SHELTER

- Tents or Shelters are properly set up and sturdy
- Suitable ground cloth & insulation under sleeping bags
- Proper sleeping bags

MEAL PREPARATION

- Suitable cooking fires:
 - Wood or charcoal properly used
 - Liquid fuels properly used and stored (transfers by ADULTS ONLY)
 - Gas cylinders (propane, butane) properly used and stored
- Hot, nourishing food (Menu posted)
- Food preparation area clean
- Garbage properly stored (for transport HOME with you)

FIRES & FUELS

- Warming fire is of a reasonable size & adult supervised
- Wood from cabin supply is NOT being used outside
- Wood chopping area clearly marked
- Fuels are properly stored (solid, liquid, gas)
- Emergency procedure in place
- If liquid fuels are being used, next campsite is more than 50' away

CLOTHING

- Scouts and leaders are properly dressed
- Scouts are warm and dry

GENERAL CAMPSITE

- Troop identification evident (flag, sign, etc.)
- First Aid kit visible (complete and location known to all Scouts & leaders)
- Duty Roster posted
- Well organized site
- Scoutmaster's Tent is marked (orange flagging tape or sign)

OTHER

- Two-deep leadership evident
- "Rules" are posted
- "Rules" are being followed

I have checked our "Deep Freeze" Campsite and it meets these standards.
