SMOKING POLICY AT CAMP BOYHAVEN

1. There will be no smoking in any buildings or at any entrance or exit of any buildings.
2. There will be no smoking in front of any campers.
3. There will be no smoking around or near gas, propane, or any other flammable liquids.
4. All cigarettes must be put out completely and placed in the cans provided at the designated smoking areas
5. There will be no smoking by anyone under the age of 18 on camp property.

SMOKING IS ALLOWED IN DESIGNATED AREAS ONLY

DRINKING WATER

Potable water is available at an outside spigot on the driveway side of the White House to the left of the Main Entrance (stairway) near the corner of the house.

Note to Friday Night Arrivers: Bring enough water with you for Friday night! It's a lot easier to tap this spigot in the daylight and when the line is short!

OUTDOOR CAMPFIRES

Use existing fire pits and fire rings only. Klondike Derby patrols will be provided with aluminum "turkey pans" in which to build their lunch fires.

PLEASE CLEAN UP YOUR CAMPFIRE AREAS before you leave Camp!! Remove garbage, foil, plastic, etc. and "pack it out". Stack charred wood beside the fire ring for the next user. Leave the area better than you found it...

SELECT A SAFE CAMPSITE

Select your campsite carefully. Use caution when camping under trees. Check for ice and weak limbs. Don't set up your tent under a widow-maker!

VEHICLE PARKING

Park in parking lots only. **DO NOT PARK ALONG BOYHAVEN ROAD.** It's a public highway. Norris Hall parking lot is a "zoo" Derby Saturday morning! Quickly drop off Scouts, sledges and gear headed for the Starting Line then park your vehicle elsewhere.
