

~ Rules ~

- **NO SNOWBALLS.** There will be no snowball throwing. Scouts disobeying this rule will be asked to leave Camp.
- **NO SLEDDING.** Sleds and Klondike Derby “sledges” may be used for transporting gear only. (This is a new Camp Boyhaven rule effective January 1, 2006).
- **NO FIREWOOD** from the cabin wood-sheds for outdoor fires. If you didn't bring your own, scavenge dead-and-down fuel in the woods around Camp.
- **NO LIQUID FUELS** unless they are used and stored per the event Brochure and the Deep Freeze Scoutmaster Instructions.
- **TWO-DEEP ADULT LEADERSHIP** in your Campsite at all times when Scouts are present. Adult leadership can include adults in nearby sites...
- Scouts are to **STAY OFF BOYHAVEN ROAD**
- **NO PARKING ALONG BOYHAVEN ROAD**
