BB Shooting Sports Belt Loop and Pin

We will be working on all the requirements for the Belt Loop and Pin for the day. Youth will work with our trained Shooting Sports staff for the entire day.

Space limited to 12 Webelos per day

Archery Shooting Sports Belt Loop and Pin

Webelos will complete all requirements for the belt loop and pin for the day. Youth will work with our trained Archery Staff for the entire day.

Space limited to 24 Webelos per day

Swimming Belt Loop and Pin

Webelos will be able to achieve both the pin and belt loop for swimming by the end of the day. Youth will work with Aquatics Staff one on one for the entire day.

Webelos who wish to participate in the program should be able to pass the beginner's swim test or the swimmer's swim test.

Also, youth who wish to participate in this program should attend a swimming meet at a school or community pool.

Space limited to 15 Webelos per day

Registration

Use the form in the back of this packet. The form should be returned ASAP. Registration is VERY LIMITED for these programs and we will be closing the sessions very quickly. All spots are on a first come, first serve basis.

Payments must be received with your registration otherwise it will not be accepted.

Cost

The cost of the program is \$35 per youth for the day.

The cost covers staffing for the day, program supplies, lunch, snacks, and all awards earned at the camp, which will be provided to them before they leave.

Arrival and Check In

All participants should plan to arrive at camp by 8:30 am on the day of your program. Check in will be at the NOVA Center/Trading Post. Please check in as soon as you arrive at camp. You can turn in your health forms here.

Here the boys will receive their Den Assignments and meet the staff that will be working with them for the day.

Medical Information

We will be providing medical coverage for the weekend as well. All first aid will be provided by our onsite Medical Officer.

All participants will need to provide a medical form to the Health Director upon arrival. You will NOT need the signature of a doctor. You will only need to fill out the class one portion of the medical form. The form is located on our website.

Pick-up/Closing Ceremony

All participants will be leaving after the closing ceremony in the late afternoon. We will be providing patches, pins, and belt loops to all youth who participated. The ceremony will be at the flag pole and will be a quick one. Everyone will be able to leave immediately afterwards.

Uniforms

If you have a pack activity shirt or any scouting t-shirt, you are encouraged to wear those for Saturday. Due to the short time frame the event we will not have an appropriate time for Class A uniforms to be worn, and we do not want to see them extremely dirty on you, so no need to bring them.

Weather Problems

Due to safety concerns, we are not able to conduct the activities during severe weather. For this reason only, we will conduct as much of the program as possible in order to get the kids their pins and belt loops. If for some reason the weather is predicted to just be too bad, we will schedule a rain date. If you are unable to attend the rain date we will issue a refund.

Refunds

Due to the fact that this program is limited to a certain amount of people, no refunds will be given for any no-shows or cancelations after the event is full and registrations are closed.

If you must cancel prior to registrations being closed out then, a refund maybe given.

The only exception is if the spot is able to be filled from a waiting list that may form. Also if you send in your registration after the session has been closed out, then we will return your check and form, with a letter indicating such.

Food

The Camp will provide lunch for all youth as part of the registration fee. Snacks consisting of fruit will be available the entire day at the Dining Hall as well as drinks.

Trading Post

The Camp Trading Post will be open for candy, sodas, ice cream, and other snacks. Plus you can pick up some Boyhaven merchandise.

Leadership/Supervision

We will be providing all the leadership and supervision for the event. This is a day only event and parents are able to drop off their youth in the morning and pick them up at the appropriate time on the schedule.
